St. James Episcopal Church, 381 High St., in Monterey


(At the corner of Franklin & High St, see map)

PRELIMINARY SET-UP of the facilities will be done between 3:30 and 5:30 p.m. by anyone who would like to help set up.

GATHERING AND REGISTRATION will take place between 5:00 and 6:00 p.m. If you would like to have dinner with us, please show up no later than 6:00 so we can count you in. Participants are invited to bring along and share pictures (in whatever format), videos, patch collections, or other memorabilia.
